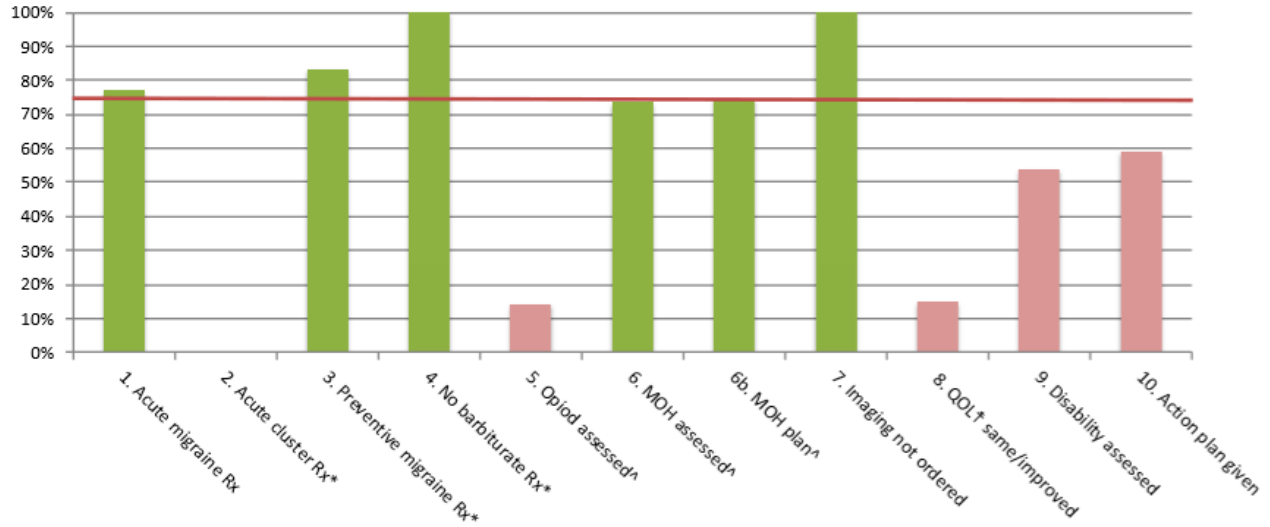

Percent of audited charts in compliance with AAN Headache Quality Measures



Bar graph showing the percentage of sampled patient charts in which each AAN Headache Quality Measure was satisfied. The horizontal red line shows the 75% compliance threshold established by the workgroup. *Measures 2-4 do not apply to children or adolescents⁵. †According to the AAN Measurement Set: PedMIDAS may be used as a QOL measure with improvement “indicated by a reduction in MIDAS disability grade...”⁵. ^The workgroup concluded that providers’ current practice of reviewing the patient’s active medication list and it showing that no opioids were prescribed or listed as taken was sufficient to satisfy Measure 5 (100% of charts audited). They suggested that a question could be added to the EMR visit template to clarify this, if necessary.
